TERMS OF THE INJUNCTION

1. The Defendant must reinstate Mr Gurcharn Singh Dhillon as director of the company England Kabaddi Federation (UK) [Company Number: 05332026] effective immediately;
2. The Defendant must reinstate Mr Ranjit Singh Dhanda as director of the company England Kabaddi Federation (UK) [Company Number: 05332026] effective immediately;
3. The Defendant must forthwith remove Mr Kewal Singh Randhewa and Rashpal Singh Atwal as directors of the company England Kabaddi Federation (UK) [Company Number: 05332026] effective immediately;
4. The Defendant must forthwith remove Mr Kulwant Singh as Secretary of the company England Kabaddi Federation (UK) [Company Number: 05332026] effective immediately;
5. The Defendant must notify Companies House that neither Mr Gurcharn Singh Dhillon nor Mr Ranjit Singh Dhanda resigned or were otherwise removed from the company England Kabaddi Federation (UK) [Company Number: 05332026] at all whatsoever;
6. The Defendant must disclose to the Applicants the name of the person who misinformed Companies House that the Applicants had resigned;
7. The Defendant must remove such person as identified in paragraph 6 above or otherwise remove Mr Surinder Singh Manak from the company England

Kabaddi Federation (UK) [Company Number: 05332026] forthwith and to update Companies House accordingly;

8. The Defendant must notify Companies House that the information provided to them regarding the applicant's resignation was false;
9. The Defendant must forthwith abandon and withdraw Claim No K8QZ7626 currently in the County Court at Reading and reimburse the defendant in that matter Mr Gurcharn Singh Dhillon of all his legal costs including any costs awarded against him in those proceedings; and
10. The Defendant must honour and implement the 13th November 2018 resolution with immediate effect and be prohibited from departing from that resolution without due consent of all the stakeholders of that resolution.
